## Hawaiian Stilt

- Endangered
  - Due to Habitat Loss and Predation
- Found on all Hawaiian Islands except Kahoolawe
- Diet of invertebrates and other aquatic organisms
- Life Span: Unknown
- Size: Length 35-39cm / Wingspan 71cm





# ‘ALAE KEA

## Hawaiian Coot

- Endemic
- Endangered
  - Due to Habitat Loss and Predation
- Found on all Hawaiian Islands except Kahoolawe
- Diet of invertebrates, seeds, aquatic leaves, and tadpoles
- Life Span: Unknown
- Size: Length 38 cm / Wingspan 63 cm





# ‘ALAE ‘ULA

## Hawaiian Moorhen

- Endemic
- Endangered
  - Due to Habitat Loss and Predation
- Found on Oahu, Kauai and possibly Maui and Molokai
- Diet of mollusks, insects, water plants, and grasses
- Life Span: Unknown
- Size: Length 38 cm / Wingspan 53 cm





# ‘AUKU‘U

## Black-crowned Night Heron

- Indigenous
- Endangered
  - Due to Habitat Loss, Predation, Non-native invasive plants, avian diseases, and environmental contaminants
- Found across Hawaiʻi
- Diet of insects, fish, frogs, mice, and the young of other native waterbirds





# KOLOA MAOLI

## Hawaiian Duck

- Endemic
- Endangered
  - Due to Habitat Loss and Predation
- Found on all Hawaiian Islands except Kahoolawe and Lanai
- Diet of mollusks, insects, and fresh water vegetation
- Life Span: 13-18 years
- Size: Length 40-50 cm / Wingspan 81-98 cm
